CSPP members contributes to organising workshops and seminars in the area of plant pathology and plant protection, held in the Czech Republic, especially Czech and Slovak Conferences on Plant Protection (CSCPP), which are organised once per three years (CSCPP Prague 2015, CSCPP Brno 2018).

The Society also supports participation of its young members in these conferences.

CSPP members create the core of Scientific Board of international scientific journal Plant Protection Science (PPS; published by Czech Academy of Agricultural Sciences), which is listed in the Web of Science in 2012, current Impact Factor = 0.742.

The head of the Scientific Board of PPS is Prof. Aleš Lebeda, former president and currently vicepresident of CSPP.
